RE: Contract Acceptance of the Street Culvert Reconstruction project #22-14; and

Authorizing staff to file a Notice of Completion with the Placer County Recorder's

Office.

Recommendation

Staff is recommending that the Town Council adopt a resolution:

- 1. Town Council adopt a resolution accepting the improvements completed by The Design Build Inc, for the Street Culvert Reconstruction project #22-14; and
- 2. Authorizing the revised construction contract amount to \$1,170,000; and
- 3. Authorizing staff to file a Notice of Completion with the Placer County Recorder's Office.

Issue Statement and Discussion

As part of the FY 2022-23 and FY 2023-24 Capital Improvements Program budget, the Street Culvert Crossing Reconstruction Project #22-14 was identified as one of the more significant projects to be completed out of the Drainage Fund. This proposed project consisted of the replacement of approximately two dozen locations around town where 12-inch to 24-inch diameter corrugated metal pipes were at various stages of failure as they cross under the roadway. Many of the pipes have rusted-out bottoms, which over time, if not replaced, will create sink holes in the roadway, become blocked with debris, and restrict the flow of water. This project will remove and replace these pipes with high-density polyethylene (HDPE) plastic pipe that is resistant to future corrosion.

The construction contract was awarded to The Design Build, Inc., a Sacramento-based contractor with 12 years of experience in similar infrastructure work. On April 9, 2024, the Town Council approved the contract in the amount of \$706,036.01 and authorized a construction budget of \$800,000, inclusive of contingencies. Subsequently, on August 13, 2024, the Town Council reallocated \$165,000 in funding from the defunded Humphrey Ditch Undergrounding Project to support the increased construction needs of the culvert project, resulting in a revised construction budget of \$965,000. Upon project completion, the total actual construction cost increased to \$1,170,000. The increased cost was due to unforeseen conflicts with SPMUD pressurized sewer line and PCWA irrigation line, which resulted in a change order for two locations. The total construction cost for Street Culvert Reconstruction project #22-14 budget is shown below:

^{*}Note, this table includes the additional \$165,000 appropriation from defunding Humphrey Ditch Undergrounding project.

At the time of completion of the project the actual expended amount was \$1,329,719, which was \$85,281 under the budgeted project total amount.

The project has been completed in accordance with the plans and specifications and to the satisfaction of the Town Engineer on May 1, 2025. In accordance with Public Contract Code Section 7107, a Notice of Completion needs to be filed with the Placer County Recorder's Office at the time the streets were accepted for beneficial use by staff and council.

CEQA Requirements

Project is CEQA exempt.

Financial and/or Policy Implications

Financial

The Street Culvert Reconstruction project #22-14 was funded through the FY 22/23 and FY 23/24 Capital Improvements Program, with allocations from American River Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) and the Drainage Development Fees (Fund 318).

The total construction costs for the project were completed at \$1,170,000, which is within the approved construction budget of \$1,215,000 but exceeds the originally appropriated amount of \$965,000 authorized by the Town Council. The total project budget, inclusive of all phases—design, construction, and construction support—was \$1,329,719. Despite the increase in construction costs, the overall project remained within the total budget target. As a result, no additional appropriation is required; however, a revision to the construction contract amount is necessary to reflect the final expenditure.
