PUBLIC COMMENT:

Paula Labourdette – Humphrey Road: Concerned about directives to staff at the last meeting

Dennis Oliviera- Rachel Lane: Thank you for public service. Asked if the directives from the last meeting is a permanent decision or still in the works.

Jennifer Cartwright –Angelo Court: Stated the website is difficult to navigate. Opposed to project, proposes too many zoning changes required. Asked how the project specifically addresses our RHNA numbers.

Laura Hasse Yamada – Rocky Hill Court: Concerned about the appearances of variances and the precedence they set for future projects.

Carol Stearns: stated that it is her opinion that this item in a part of a bigger “Agenda 21” issue and is concerned about the effect on our town and beyond our borders.

Kyle Black- David Ave: Opposed to the project citing concerns about parking, traffic, density, cost to the town residents.

Jennifer Maletti- Voiced concern about the effect this project will have on crime in town, traffic and “feel” of the town.

Craig Markum – Lawnview: Opposed to the project citing concerns about density, traffic, parking and increasing crime.

Judy Grayson- Casell Lane: Opposed to the project as it deviates too far from the general plan.

Irene Hayes – Mareta Lane: Opposes growth. We do not want to become a “Rocklin” or Roseville”.

Sandra Calvert – Indian Creek: Opposes project citing concerns that it will promote growth/ lot splits and development. Stick with the general plan.

Gary Huntsinger- Arcadia: Opposed to the project citing concerns about lot coverage, small lot size, setbacks. Wants to condition project to stick with the general plan.

John Probasco- Horseshoe Bar Road: Long time Loomis resident. Opposed to the project, citing concerns about increased traffic. Wants project to adhere to the general plan.

Gary Liss- Gold Trail: Would like to see a more concise staff report / recommended action in the packets, available for each meeting. Voiced concerns about the “rushing” between meetings, asked to allow enough time to fully prepare for meetings.

Jackie Euer- King Road: Concerned about “fast tracking” project. Is in favor of pursuing Swetzer Rd extension. Is concerned about traffic and parking issues and is opposed to the project.
