- 1. Chair Jenny Knisley called the meeting to order at 6:10 pm

- 3. Public Comment: Carol Pepper-Kittredge discussed the Rocklin Mini-Maker Faire on the Sierra College campus on October 14, 2017 and the "Call for Makers" that is still open. The LLCC and/or Friends might want to participate as the event is expected to have 8,000-10,000 attendees this year.
