RE: Authorization to Enter into Legal Services Contract with Remy Moose Manley, LLP for

CEQA Representation on Costco Project

### Recommendation

Staff recommends Council authorize the Town to enter into a legal services agreement (Attachment A) with Remy Moose Manley, LLP, to advise the Town on California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) compliance for the Loomis Costco project.

#### **Issue Statement and Discussion**

As Council knows, the Town will be releasing in the upcoming months the Recirculated Draft Environmental Impact Report (RDEIR) for the Loomis Costco project. Because of a conflict with the Town Attorney's firm Kronick Moskovitz Tiedemann & Girard, the Town will need to hire a CEQA Attorney to represent the Town in the event of any potential litigation.

Remy Moose Manley, LLP, is a very highly-regarded CEQA firm throughout the state and comes highly recommended by Town Attorney Jeff Mitchell. The firm routinely represents both public and private clients on land use and CEQA matters.
