RECOMMENDATIONS & COMMENTS FROM SUBCOMMITTEES



INPUT FROM THE BIOLOGICAL RESOURCES & OPEN SPACE SUBCOMMITTEE

- » Maintain and expand tree canopy
- » Connect trails and open space
- »Expand use of existing trails and add new trails
- » Protect water quality in surface waters for habitat
- » Private open space in low-density designations
- »Open space for recreation and habitat preservation
- » Encourage volunteers for management of open space
- » Emphasize educational components of open space resources
- »Incorporate measurable objectives for open space management
- » Review 2006 recommendation report for open spaces



INPUT FROM THE AIR QUALITY, GREENHOUSE GAS EMISSIONS, & CLIMATE SUBCOMMITTEE

- » Identify opportunities for collaboration, incentives, external funding, such as California Air Resources Board and local Placer County Air Pollution Control District funding grants for vehicle electrification and other programs.
- » Interconnection between land use and housing decisions, and benefits to air quality, greenhouse gas emissions, and energy.
- » Opportunities to incentivize / partner with the school district to address mobile source emissions.
- » Provide indicator within and between elements for policies that cross disciplines for implementation and/or provide co-benefits.
- » Inform land use planning, particularly near railroad and freeway, to reduce health risks from air pollutants.
- » Maintain and expand tree canopy and multi-use trail system for open space and between key destinations.
- » Promote electric vehicles, solar, and other technologies.
- » Financing & other incentives for energy efficiency improvements and renewable energy for existing buildings.



INPUT FROM THE CULTURAL AND HISTORIC RESOURCES SUBCOMMITTEE

- » Committee members have recommended knowledgeable people and sources of information for further historical research.
- » Committee members have specific buildings and structures of concern for a possible local inventory.
- » There is a great deal of interest in the early Japanese farmers in the region with proposed commemorations of the history of the group through an event in 2022.
- » There is concern for the preservation and enrichment of the historic character of downtown.
- » Interest in having local students from Sierra College or other schools volunteer to prepare historic background or site specific text.
- » Interest in further development of historic trails.
