Notice of Intent to Adopt a Mitigated Negative Declaration for the *Routine Maintenance of Stream Channels and Drainage Facilities*

WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The Town of Loomis proposes to establish a Routine Maintenance Agreement (RMA) with the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) to authorize the Town to perform routine maintenance activities, qualifying capital improvement projects, and vegetation restoration activities within areas of CDFW jurisdiction. The completed RMA will streamline permitting and environmental clearance for routine maintenance tasks within the Town.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

In accordance with the California Environmental Quality Act, the Town of Loomis has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. An Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration (ISMND) has been prepared to summarize the environmental impacts of implementing the RMA and disclose those impacts to the public. This notice is to inform you that the ISMND has been completed and is available for public review and comment. The document is available for review between the dates of **May 14, 2021** and **June 14, 2021**. If you have questions or comments regarding the findings of the Initial Study, please submit a written comment to the Town before the deadline of **June 14, 2021**.
