SUMMARY OF COMMENTS RECEIVED

- » **Continue pursuing a King Road Interchange.**
- » **Frontage Road between Horseshoe Bar and King Road could help alleviate queuing at off-ramps.**
- » **Doc Barns Drive extension is needed.**
- » **Traffic problems caused by growth in surrounding areas.**
- » **Speeding issues in the Town should be addressed.**
- » **New overpass connecting Swetzer Road and Rippey Road.**
- » **New road parallel to train tracks connecting Swetzer Road and English Colony Way in Newcastle.**
- » **Railroad overpass or tunnel between Sierra College Boulevard and King Road.**
- » **Improvements to Bankhead Road.**



SUMMARY OF COMMENTS RECEIVED

- » **Roads need to be repaved.**
- » **Need a bike lane and walking path along Horseshoe Bar Road between Laird Road and the I-80 Interchange.**
- » **A bike/pedestrian trail could be constructed along the creek between Horseshoe Bar Road and Brace Road.**
- » **Need a longer I-80 on-ramp.**
- » **Support for new roundabouts.**
- » **Carpool pickup location for commuting to Sacramento (park-and-ride lot).**
- » **New road that runs parallel to downtown so streets can be closed off to vehicles for events.**
- » **Traffic traveling between the Del Oro High School and the freeway causes significant congestion on Taylor Road.**



SUMMARY OF COMMENTS RECEIVED

- » **Roads need to be repaved.**
- » **Sierra College Boulevard has become the favored commute route for Lincoln, Rocklin, and Roseville.**
- » **Safety issue at the Walnut Street crosswalks across Taylor Road.**
- » **Concerns over increased congestion, GHGs, and time spent in traffic.**
- » **Would like to see reintroduction of school buses.**
- » **Questions on source of future traffic forecasts.**
- » **Promote use of electric vehicles.**

- Delete those that are complete, not relevant, or non-compliant

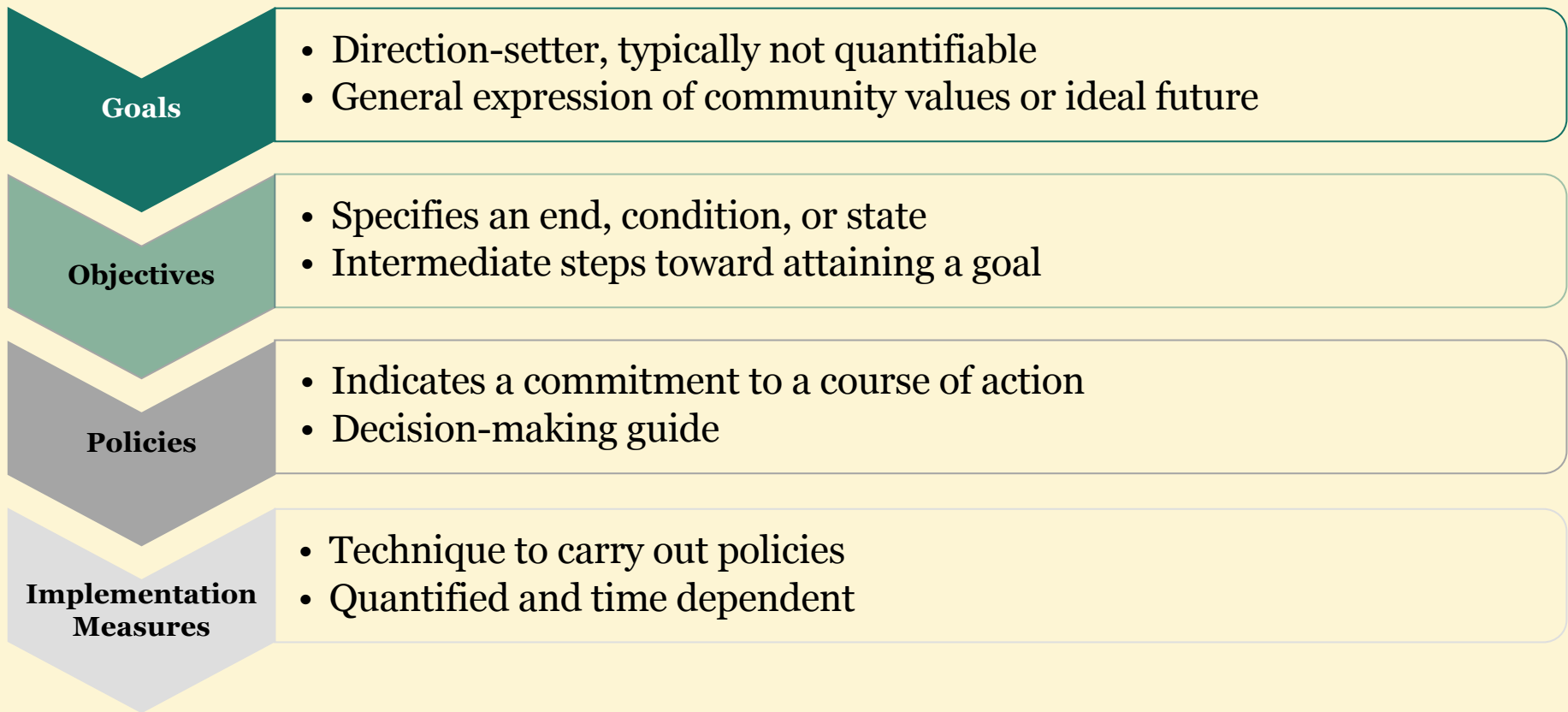
» Reorganize the goals, policies, and implementation measures with a numbering system.

- #Goal
 - #.#Objective
 - #.#.# Policy
 - #.#.#.#Implementation Measure
- Add objectives where they were not included before – these serve as measurable outcomes that allow the Town to track progress toward goals.

- » Has this policy/program been effective?
- » Does the policy/program address the corresponding goal?
- » Is the text appropriate?
- » Has this been completed or is no longer relevant?
- » Does this belong in another element?
- » How can existing policies/programs be strengthened?
- » Are there issues not addressed by the existing element that should be?
- » Which goals, policies, and implementation measures correspond with one another?



GAPS AND OPPORTUNITIES

- » Keep overall Goals with minor adjustments.
- » Add Objectives to corral the policies by topic.
- » Add policies regarding Vehicle Miles Traveled?
- » Adjust policies regarding Level of Service?
- » Add policies regarding connectivity?
- » Add policies on ride sharing?
- » Add policies regarding environmental justice in transportation?
- » Add policies regarding designating land for trails?
- » Any others?
