**Recommendation:**

Direct staff to use general fund reserves to award contract to J& S Asphalt to resurface the basketball court at the Sunrise-Loomis Park facility at a not-to-exceed cost of \$4,850.

**Issue Statement and Discussion**

At the Town Council budget hearings in June, Councilmember Ucovich requested that staff look into the cost to resurface the basketball court at the Sunrise-Loomis Park. Staff made contact with several local companies that provided resurfacing services. Staff received two proposals to do the work (attached).

**CEQA Requirements**

This project was exempt under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Section 15301. (c&d) (Class 1), "Existing Facilities" of the guidelines.

**Financial and/or Policy Implications**

Funding source would come from the General Fund Reserve account.
