Subject: Authorizing The Town Manager to spend up to \$15,000 in Park Improvement Fees to upgrade the Blue Anchor Park Security Surveillance System

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize The Town Manager to spend up to \$15,000 in Park Improvement Fees to upgrade the Blue Anchor Park Security Surveillance System

DISCUSSION:

Over the last 3 years the Town has relied on a surveillance system at Blue Anchor Park consisting of 16 cameras recording on a PC based DVR. The system has become severely unreliable and technologically outdated. Recently the system has been down approximately 80-85% of the time. Recent vandalism has occurred directly under a camera, however, the system was down and nothing was recorded.

Staff met onsite with a security system expert and learned of new system which would include all High Definition cameras (vandal proof), 10 of which will be able to zoom and swivel remotely. The system would be made available to the Sheriff's Department for use on their mobile devices as well as in police cruiser vehicle monitors.

Staff is seeking authorization from the Town Council to spend up to \$15,000 of Park Facility Improvement Funds to purchase and install a new surveillance system for Blue Anchor Park.
