RE: CONSENT ITEM TOWN HALL DEDICATION PLAQUE

ISSUE

Decide on wording for a dedication plaque for the new Town Hall.

RECOMMENDATION

Approve plaque wording and design as noted or as Council may edit, and authorize plaque to be obtained in preparation for a dedication date.

CEQA

There are no CEQA issues because it is self evident that a plaque will not impact the environment.

MONEY

The cost of a plaque, like the one placed at the Depot, will be under \$1,000.00 dollars and come from the capital building fund that is being used to do the remodel work.

DISCUSSION

The Town Hall remodel will be completed early 2010 and it would be prudent to get plaque wording and costs confirmed so that the plaque could be available when the dedication takes place. The current timing is to move into the new facility in February and dedication could occur as early as the March Council meeting.

Following is suggested wording for a bronze plaque that would be the same style and size as the one at the Depot.
