Subject: Proposed Union Pacific Track Replacement Schedule

ISSUE AND DISCUSSION:

This item involves the proposed Union Pacific Railroad track replacement project through Loomis. Loomis staff has been in contact with Union Pacific representatives since the last Town Council meeting expressing our concerns and desires regarding the proposed road closures at King, Webb and Sierra College Boulevard in Loomis.

On November 16, 2011, a conference call was held with a representative of Union Pacific and the company in charge of notification of the public of road closures. Present during the call were Victoria Skellenger, Deputy from the Placer County Sheriff's department, Fire Chief for Penryn, Fire Chief for Loomis, Brian Fragio and myself.

The Union Pacific representative understood our concerns and committed to work with us so that there would be no lengthy closures of any of the crossings in Loomis.

I have scheduled for a representative from Union Pacific to be present to discuss the current status of the project. Please note that we were advised today (December 5, 2011) that work through Loomis is now not scheduled until 2012 (presumably in January).
