



TOWN COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS FOR SEPTEMBER

Councilmember Robert Black:

Placer County Air Pollution Control District – The board met on August 11th, and passed their 2016-2017 fiscal Budgets for the District. The board issued a grant of \$15,000.00 for the Sierra Foothills Meat Company for a feasibility analysis for a biomass slaughterhouse. The board was presented with proposed CEQA thresholds to revise and establish greenhouse gas thresholds for the California Environmental Quality ACT (CEQA) review process. An update was presented on the District's biomass programs, no action taken.

Business Liaison - I met with the Chamber of Commerce, and discussed the current plans for the downtown, the program for branding in Loomis, and outreach to the businesses in town.
