

TOWN COUNCIL COMMITTEE REPORTS FOR JUNE

Councilmember Robert Black:

- 1. Placer County Air Pollution Control District The Board met and awarded 17 clean air grants to various agencies and companies in the district, to remove polluting machinery and equipment, and replace them with newer more efficient engines and equipment. The Board also attended the annual Clean Air Awards Ceremony at Sacramento State University among the recipients were the City of Rocklin, recognized for their achievements in air pollution reductions.
- 2. School Liaison The Town Manager and I met with Loomis School Superintendent Gordon Medd and Del Oro High School Principal Dan Gayaldo. The suggestion was made that the Town partner with the High School to have a student representative report monthly to the Town Council on activities with the High School and other issues that Town could assist the School District. Mr. Gayaldo will work with a committee to select the representative.
- 3. Business Liaison The Town Manager and I are meeting with the Chamber of Commerce Economic Development Committee this week, to discuss an ADA Compliance incentive program, and review the business needs and challenges the Town's businesses face and look for solutions.

1. Local Agency Formation Commission – He was appointed chairman for the coming year.
