RE: Countywide Homelessness Task Force Representatives

Recommendation

Staff recommends the Town Council appoint two Council Members to the new Placer County Homelessness Task Force.

Issue Statement and Discussion

Placer County is in the process of creating a new countywide Homelessness Task Force to determine strategies for preventing and addressing homelessness. The Taskforce will include elected representatives from each city, the Town, and the County.

While homelessness in Placer County isn't nearly as prevalent in Placer County as in nearby counties, the county still has issues with homelessness that need to be addressed. Loomis, for example, has a few homeless encampments (one of which recently caused a fire on a vacant property next to the Loomis Library and Community Learning Center).

The new Taskforce will begin working collaboratively on this issue this month. It is important that the Town participate in these meetings as the decisions made during the Taskforce process will need need to be implemented on a Countywide basis. The Town Council should appoint two Council Members to the Taskforce (by motion). I will attend as Staff.
