**3. #16-17 TAYLOR ROAD MIXED USE PROJECT
TENTATIVE TRACT, CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT, DESIGN REVIEW MODIFICATION
APN: 044-123-059 & 068
APPLICANT: PAT CANNON**

The Taylor Road Mixed Use Project was originally approved by the Town of Loomis on December 20, 2005 and subsequently extended to December 20, 2018. Currently the project consists of two parcels, divided into 45 lots (33 residential, 11 commercial and 1 open space).

The proposed modification will decrease the number of lots and the number and mix of dwelling units, while increasing open space, and leaving the same number of commercial lots.

RECOMMENDATION

The Planning Commission adopt Resolution #17-09 to modify the Tentative Tract Map, Conditional Use Permit, and subject to the findings and the revised conditions of approval, and adopt the previous Mitigated Negative Declaration and Addendum as per the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA).


Commissioner Wilson: Led a discussion on drainage / detention pond
