Brief presentation by consultant Mark Teague followed by a committee and public line by line discussion on the Policies for specifics areas in this sub committees study area

Bonnie London – Asked to revisit the request for photos showing development that fits this area.

Committee wide discussion on vision in the area:

Miguel Ucovich- Stated he would like the area to remain commercial

<u>Jean Wison</u> – Voiced concern over a "commercial corridor" along Brace

Ryan DeMartini – Stated that he would like the area to be commercial

<u>Ramona Brockman</u> – Supports commercial but voiced caution in developing as to not undercut the Downtown Businesses, requesting we check with our Downtown consultant Michele Reeves what er thoughts are on this subject.

<u>Jesse Lunsford</u> – Proposed a 100' no development along the Highway as a buffer – Bonnie London concurred. <u>Jean Wilson</u> – Spoke on a previous survey where the Downtown businesses support the commercial development in this area

<u>Jan Clark-Crets</u> – Stated the area is good for commercial, "Nut-Tree" type business and other rural type commercial businesses, she favors secondary access (limited) off of Brace Road, she noted that we have received no requests for zoning changes in the area and recommends we proceed slowly.

Greg Obranovich stated his preference for no commercial development along Brace Road.
