PROCLAMATION

FOR

SEPTEMBER 17 – 23 AS CONSTITUTION WEEK

WHEREAS, September 17, 1787 delegates to the Constitution Convention in Philadelphia signed the United States Constitution, which established our national government and fundamental laws, and has protected and guaranteed certain basic rights to citizens of the United States of America; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting and proper to accord official recognition to this magnificent document and its memorable anniversary, and to the patriotic celebrations which will commemorate the occasion; and

WHEREAS, Public Law 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through 23 as CONSTITUTION WEEK.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY PROCLAIMED by the Town of Loomis that the week of September 17 through 23 as CONSTITUTION WEEK and ask our citizens to reaffirm the ideals the Framers of the Constitution had in 1787 by vigilantly protecting the freedoms guaranteed to us through this guardian of our liberties, remembering that lost rights may never be regained.
