
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NEW PARK LOCATIONS

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COUNTING OTHER PARKS

» Parkland Ratio - DECIDED

• Established Ratio: 5 acres per 1,000 residents

» Determine how to count non-town-owned parks:

- Regional Parks (33 acres, full access)
- School Facilities (~39.2 acres, partial access and not guaranteed in long-term)



DECISION POINT

- »Should the Town count park facilities at schools identified in joint use agreements?
 - If yes: Move onto next question.
 - If no: Done.
- » What percent should the Town use to count park facilities at schools identified in joint use agreements?
 - PlaceWorks to do live calculations of how percentage influences existing parkland ratio.
- » Does the Committee want to include all types of parks and open space in one parkland ratio?
 - If yes: Done.
 - If no: Move on to next question.
