BUSINESS

12. American Rescue Plan

On March 11, 2021, President Biden signed into law the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA), in response to the Covid-19 pandemic, which allocated \$1,624,494 to the Town of Loomis. There are four specified allowable uses for these funds The final overriding requirement is that whatever project is chosen, it serves as many citizens as possible.

Recommendation

Discuss alternatives for using the American Rescue Plan Act funds and provide staff direction.

Feedback and Ideas for use of the American Rescue Plans Act Funds:

Staff recommendation for repairing damaged/worn Storm Drainage System.

<u>Councilmember Clark-Crets</u> asked for defined verbiage for use of the funds- suggested legal advice.

<u>Councilmember Cartwright</u> asked about the "Clean -Water" referenced in the allowable uses of the grant funds – inquiring if that was an exclusive use of the funds.

ADOPT RESOLUTION

<u>Councilmember Baker</u> discussed the deterioration of the drainage system and the development of sink holes in the area and agreed that this is a good use of the funds.

<u>Councilmember Knisley</u> asked that we take a comprehensive look at the needs in Loomis and use the funds to the benefit of the entire community.

Councilmember Baker asked about the option of a single project or multiple uses of the funds.

Mayor Duncan stated that the infrastructure repairs is a good place to start.

Public Response:

<u>Pam Blake</u> commented on the entrance to the Fire House on Horseshoe Bar was not a safe entrance and that we could use funds to improve this entrance.

<u>Jean Wilson</u> – asked that we not rush into a decision, that we vet out ideas. She also stated that Storm drain repair and public health is a broad area of discussion, and she asked that we look at ideas to improve senior living.

<u>David Ring</u> – discussed that we look into synchronize the traffic lights on Swetzer to improve air quality. He stated that storm drain repair could lead to broadband repair.

<u>Miguel Ucovich</u> stated that storm drain repair on Walnut / Magnolia area be looked into. He also suggested that a new air conditioning system be considered for the library.

Council members suggested that staff bring back specific ideas to discuss at an upcoming council meeting.

<u>Councilmember Baker</u> – Hardcore Infrastructure repair. Also suggested improvements to the outdoors spaces for public use in town.

<u>Councilmember Knisley</u> In addition to the previously mentioned ideas, she would like to see the Broadband report from the County outlining broadband availability and services.

<u>Councilmember Cartwright</u> – Stormwater and Drainage system repairs. Open to alternate options if funds allow.

<u>Councilmember Clark-Crets</u>- Stormwater and Drainage system repairs. Also open to alternate options if funds allow.

Mayor Duncan: Stormwater and Drainage system repairs. Also open to alternate options if funds allow.
