Issue Statement and Discussion

Each year the State of California allocates funds for transportation needs. These funds flow through the Placer County Transportation Planning Agency (PCTPA) and are allocated throughout the county based on population. A portion of those funds are to be used, specifically, for pedestrian walkways and bike lanes.

In prior years, \$31,815 was advance to the Town from these funds for use on the Downtown Master Plan Phase 3. The application of those funds to the project needs to be reported to the PCTPA.

There are also \$107,585 available for the Town's use for the current year, through the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025. We have been informed by PCTPA that the recent project which installed flashing beacons at five crosswalks on Taylor Road would qualify for use of those funds.

Although the amount of money is set aside for use by the Town, we are required to file forms to request the fund. These forms inform the Agency the amount of the funds requested and the purpose to which they were applied.

CEQA Requirements

There are no CEQA issues.

Financial and/or Policy Implications

Failure to file these claim forms would delay or prevent the Town from receiving \$111,195 for use on the Town's Transit and Transportation systems and require the repayment of \$31,815 advanced to the Town in the past.
