

TOWN OF LOOMIS
Compost Direct Service Provider Agreement

This Agreement is made and entered into as of the approval date shown at the bottom of this agreement, by and between the Town of Loomis ("Town") and _____ ("Service Provider").

RECITALS

Under Senate Bill 1383, a State-sponsored program that is trying to reduce the amount of organic material placed in landfills, the Town is obligated to purchase approximately 630 cubic yards of compost per year. This compost can be used by the Town directly or given away, but it cannot be sold. In order for the Town to offer complimentary compost to residents, in quantities larger than what is available at the Corporation Yard's Self-Serve Compost Bin, the program requires that residents enter into a written agreement with the Town and become a "Direct Service Provider". The service provided being the acceptance of compost at the production facility in Roseville, which eliminates the cost the Town would otherwise have to pay in order to have the material hauled to Loomis. This agreement is also used as a way of communicating to the composting facility, the name of the person authorized to obtain complimentary compost, on behalf of the Town.

AGREEMENT

WHEREAS, the Town of Loomis is in need of a Service Provider that will take delivery of compost from the composting facility in Roseville. The Town is offering compost at no cost provided that the Service Provider provides their own transportation to haul the compost, acknowledges that they are the end user of the compost, and agrees not to sell the compost to others; and

WHEREAS, the Service Provider is willing to take delivery of the compost under the conditions stated above.

NOW, THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

1. Town agrees to offer complimentary compost to the Service Provider, stockpiled at the West Placer Waste Management Authority's (WPWMA) composting facility at 3033 Fiddymont Road in Roseville, in the estimated quantity stated below.
2. The Service Provider agrees to take delivery of the compost and not sell it to others.
