**Traffic Signal and Interconnect Project**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Town of Loomis is seeking proposals from qualified professional consulting firms to provide design services for the Town's Traffic Signal and Interconnect Project. Work scope generally includes:

- Preparation of design drawings, technical specifications, and environmental documents for one (1) new traffic signal and the interconnection of this new signal to three (3) other existing traffic signals with conduit runs, surface restoration, new or modified controller equipment, and signal timing modifications.

The design phase is funded with local funds, however, construction will use federal funds. The consultant should therefore have a strong working knowledge of requirements spelled out in the Caltrans Local Assistance Procedures Manual. Consultant will be responsible for coordinating with Caltrans on the completion of all work necessary to obtain NEPA/CEQA environmental approvals, shall obtain all other clearances, and shall complete all other paperwork necessary to obtain the E-76 for construction, on the Town's behalf.
