RE: Authorize a Change Order to the Construction Contract with Kroeker, Inc. and

Appropriate \$60,000 from the Park Development Fund to the Concrete Repair

Project #22-04

Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Town Council adopt a resolution (1) authorizing a change order in the amount of \$61,652 to the construction contract with Kroeker, Inc. for concrete repair work in Sunrise Loomis Park, and (2) appropriating \$60,000 from the Park Development Fund to the Concrete Repair Project #22-04.

Issue Statement and Discussion

In September 2022, the Town Council awarded a contract to Kroeker, Inc. to complete concrete repairs and drainage modifications at the Taylor Road/Horseshoe Bar intersection, to complete a new sidewalk on Webb Street at Taylor Road, and to remove and replace damaged curb, gutter and sidewalk at miscellaneous locations around town.

The Town has a need to complete additional concrete repair work in Sunrise Loomis Park. Staff completed an assessment of the concrete pathways and drainage gutters, marked the removal and replacement limits in white paint, and quantified the work to be done (See Attachment B). The contractor provided a quote for this work, in the amount of \$61,652 (See Attachment C), which staff reviewed and is recommending for approval as being as good, if not better, than it would receive by putting another project out for bids. In completing the work by change order, the contractor can pass along some savings, in that, they are already mobilized in Town and the work represents off-season, winter, filler-work. There are also savings to the Town in not having to administer a separate project.

Staff is recommending that the Town Council approve the additional concrete repair scope of work at Sunrise Loomis Park proposed by change order, and provide a project appropriation of \$60,000, which when added to other project contingency funds, will cover the cost of the work.

CEQA Requirements

The proposed concrete repair work is Categorically Exempt from the provisions of CEQA as a Class I Exemption, Section 15301(c) (Maintenance of existing public facilities, with no expansion of use).

Financial and/or Policy Implications

In September 2022, the Town Council authorized a construction budget for the project in the amount of \$300,000. Appropriating an additional \$60,000 in funding from the Park Development Fund (316.4) will increase the construction budget to \$360,000, which will be sufficient to complete the proposed change order work for concrete repairs in Sunrise Loomis Park. The Park Development Fund is an appropriate funding source as it is a restricted fund that can only be spent in Town parks. Sufficient funding is available in the Park Development Fund for the recommended appropriation.

WHEREAS, in September 2022, the Town Council awarded a construction contract for concrete repair work to Kroeker, Inc. with a construction budget of \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, the Town has identified the need to complete additional concrete repair work in Sunrise Loomis Park; and

WHEREAS, Kroeker provided a quote for this additional work in the amount of \$61,652, which staff has reviewed and is recommending for approval by change order; and

WHEREAS, to cover the cost of the additional work, an appropriation in the amount of \$60,000 will need to be made; and

WHEREAS, it is recommended that \$60,000 be appropriated from the Park Development Fund (316.4) to the Concrete Repair Project #22-04; and


WHEREAS, there are sufficient funds available in the Park Development Fund for the recommended appropriation.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of Loomis hereby authorizes a change order in the amount of \$61,652, to the construction contract with Kroeker, Inc., for concrete repair work in Sunrise Loomis Park; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that \$60,000 is appropriated from the Park Development Fund (316.4) to the Concrete Repair Project #22-04.
