ASBESTOS IN BUILDING MATERIALS

If your project is a demolition or renovation or commercial tenant improvement, an **Asbestos NESHAPS Declaration of Notification Compliance form** must be filled out.

If you answer Y/Yes to any of the questions, an inspection must be conducted by a California Division of Occupational Safety and Health (DOSH) Certified Asbestos Consultant (CAC) prior to renovation/demolition.

A Notification of Demolition and Renovation form along with the inspection report must be sent to:

U.S. EPA, Region IX, Enforcement Division (2-1), Attn: Asbestos NESHAP Program, 75 Hawthorne Street, San Francisco, CA 94105.

For Placer County demolitions and/or renovations, a copy of the notification must be sent to:

California Air Resources Board, Attn: Enforcement Division, Asbestos NESHAP Program, P.O. Box 2815, Sacramento, CA 95812; or faxed to (916) 229-0645.

Attach a copy to the permit application.

List of possible asbestos components

- Fire-retardant material and thermal and acoustic insulator
- Thermal insulation
- Blown-in attic insulation
- Corrugated heavy duty 8 by 4 foot panels
- Fiber cement siding (usually 1/8 inches thick and 8 by 4 foot brittle)
- Glue that attaches floor tiles to concrete or wood
- Heating, Ventilation, and Air Conditioning (HVAC) duct insulation (usually found in corrugated or flat paper form)
- Plaster
- Roofing material (usually on flat roofs but occasionally on asbestos shingles sometimes called transite)
- Siding material
- Some forms of linoleum
- Some forms of paint
- Vinyl floor tiles
- Window caulking and glazing
