

STREET MAINTENANCE NOTIFICATION

RESURFACING WORK COMING SOON

Over the next four weeks, the Town of Loomis will be performing street resurfacing work on the streets shown on the map below. As part of this work, the streets will be **closed to traffic** between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm. Look to the "No Parking" signs that will be posted along the roadway for the actual date that the street is scheduled. Work will be performed in two phases.

<u>Phase 1 – Rubberized Chip Seal (September 26 – October 3)</u>: Hot liquid asphalt with melted tire rubber will be applied to the street surface and then immediately covered by aggregate rocks called "chips". This treatment takes about 1 hour to cure before the street can be reopened to traffic.


<u>Phase 2 - Slurry Seal (October 13 – October 20)</u>: About two weeks after the rubberized chip seal is placed, the street will receive a slurry seal. The slurry seal is a mixture of sand, oil, and water which will cover the chip seal, harden, and provide a smooth, finished street surface. The initial curing of this treatment takes about 3 to 4 hours before the street can be reopened to traffic, depending upon the temperature that day, as this determines how fast the water in the mix can evaporate.


In order to clean, prep and perform the resurfacing work, all vehicles must be removed from the street for the entire day that work is scheduled. Any cars parked within the area posted for "No Parking" during the dates and time indicated will be subject to towing at the owner's expense.
