A. Consideration of Text Amendment to Article 12, Section 12.10 of the Lowell Development Ordinance (LDO)

Alex Blackburn requested a clarification of the LDO requiring residents when maintaining large vehicles and RVs. The current wording simply states twice a year and no more than 90 days for a structure and not to be parked in the street. The City would like to change it back to the old UDO (Unified Development Ordinance) verbiage where vehicles are not to be forward of more than 25 ft behind the front of the building, twice a year and no more than 30 days. This would limit residents from keeping vehicles out on the front or side of yard for a long period of time. Motion was made by John Cantrell, seconded by Troy Roberts Sr. and unanimously in favor by the group.
