




## The citizen is at the heart of everything we do, and we have the values to prove it

The City of Lucas was incorporated in 1959 and adopted its Home Rule Charter in 2008 and operates under the Council-Manager form of government. The City Council is composed of seven members, including the Mayor and six council members elected atlarge and is responsible for enacting local legislation, adopt budgets, determine policies, and provide for the adoption and execution of the laws of the City. The City currently has 44 full-time employees who staff departments in Administration, Finance, Development Services, Public Works/Engineering, and Fire-Rescue. While the City operates without a dedicated police department, it proudly partners with the Collin County Sheriff's Office, ensuring the community's safety through assigned deputies who diligently patrol Lucas.

The City is in excellent financial position with AA+ bond rating and current annual budget of \$18.9 million. The City has one of the lowest property tax rates in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The current property tax rate is \$0.256758 cents per \$100 of valuation. The City's strong financial position is evidenced by its ability to receive the prestigious Certificate of Achievement for Excellence in Financial Reporting from the Government Finance Officers Association for the 13th consecutive year.



Lucas has three public parks available to the public: Lucas Community Park, Kenneth R. Lewis Park, and Forest Creek Park. The Trinity Trail at Lavon Lake borders along the eastern boundaries of Lucas and is a 25-mile trail available for horse riding, hiking, or running. Lucas also borders along Lavon Lake, offering residents convenient access to two boat ramps and excellent fishing opportunities, enhancing their ability to fully enjoy recreational activities on the lake.

The City of Lucas has many events to create a sense of community and to provide an opportunity to socialize. Some of its premier events include the Lucas Farmers Market, Founders Day Country Fair, Lucas Car Show and Country Christmas. The Lucas Farmers Market, guided by the mission statement, 'To create a safe and pleasant social experience for our community and visitors by providing access to local farmers, food producers, and artists,' earned the prestigious ICMA Program Excellence Award for Community Partnership in September 2022. 
