#### **Prevent & Report Illegal Dumping**

Illegal dumping is more than just an eyesore—it's a serious threat to our water quality. When trash, chemicals, or yard waste are improperly discarded in ditches, storm drains, or waterways, they can contaminate the very water we rely on. Stormwater from drainage ditches works its way into our creeks and eventually into Lake Lavon and Lake Ray Hubbard. That means any dumped waste can introduce harmful bacteria, toxic chemicals, and debris into our water system, endangering aquatic life and possibly contaminating drinking water supply. Clean stormwater is also essential for safe and enjoyable lake recreation and dumped materials threaten swimming. fishing, and boating in our local lakes.

A clean environment starts at home, with responsible waste disposal. In partnership with CWD, the City of Lucas offers convenient options for bulk and hazardous waste disposal. To explore disposal options, please visit lucastexas.us/cwd or call 972-392-9300, Option 2.
