Regular Agenda

1. Discuss budget recommendations in preparation of the Fiscal Year 2025/26 Parks Budget.

MOTION: A motion was made by Member Bellows, seconded by Member Miller, to approve the recommended Parks budget for the Fiscal Year 2025/2026. The motion passed unanimously.

2. Discuss a date in October 2025 for Movie in the Park.

MOTION: A motion was made by Member Bellows, seconded by Member Martinez to hold the Movie in the Park event on October 3, 2025.. The motion passed unanimously.

3. Discuss and provided staff direction on a possible July 4th, 2026, city-wide event.

City Manager, John Whitsell brought forward to the Board the idea of hosting a city-wide event to celebrate July 4th, 2026. The Board members unanimously expressed their excitement and support for the proposal, agreeing that it would be a wonderful opportunity to bring the community together. The consensus was to move ahead with plans to hold the event on Saturday, July 4th, 2026, at Brockdale Park, organizing it as an all-hands-on-deck effort involving City staff, departments, and volunteers. The event will feature live entertainment, food trucks, and a spectacular fireworks display, all designed to create a festive, family-friendly

atmosphere. To keep each City event unique and special, rides and booths will continue to be reserved for Country Christmas and Founders Day, allowing the July 4th celebration to focus on music, food, and community spirit. No motion required.

4. Provide an update on Special Events: Keep Lucas Beautiful, Founder's Day and the Lucas Car Show.

Communication and Event Specialist Donna Bradshaw provided updates on three recent City events. Despite being rained out, the Keep Lucas Beautiful event still saw dedicated volunteers collect approximately 250 pounds of trash, highlighting the community's strong spirit of service. The Founder's Day celebration was blessed with beautiful weather and featured carnival rides, live entertainment, food trucks, and the ever-popular stick horse rodeo, which delighted children and families alike. The community shared enthusiastic feedback about the event, enjoying the chance to come together for a day filled with fun, tradition, and neighborly spirit. Meanwhile, the Lucas Car Show was held at a new location that seemed to improve the overall flow. It drew 115 entries and included two food trucks, which comfortably served the crowd. Although the threat of rain may have kept a few additional car entries away, the event was still a success and warmly received by attendees. No motion required.
