Proposers should demonstrate a strong background in similar construction projects, emphasizing their ability to deliver high-quality work within budget and on schedule. The selected contractor will be responsible for the comprehensive design and execution of the project, ensuring compliance with all applicable local codes and regulations.

Submission Requirements

All bids must be received at the designated location by the deadline shown above. Late submissions will not be considered and shall be deemed void and unacceptable. Bidders must submit one (1) original and two (2) copies of their proposal in a sealed envelope clearly marked with the RFP number. **Electronic or faxed submissions will not be accepted.**

Project Delivery Method

This project will be delivered using the Design/Build method. The selected contractor will be responsible for both design and construction services under a single contract.

Bid Bond Requirement

All bidders are required to submit a bid bond with their proposal. The bid bond must be in the form of a certified check, surety bond, or other acceptable security, and must be in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total bid submitted. The bid bond serves as a guarantee that, if awarded the contract, the bidder will enter into a formal contract and provide the required performance bond (100% of the contract price) and insurance. The bid bond must accompany the proposal and will be returned to unsuccessful bidders after award. Failure to submit a bid bond in the required amount will result in disqualification.

Insurance and Proposal Validity

The successful contractor must provide proof of insurance, including general liability, workers' compensation, and automobile coverage, in amounts specified in the RFP. Proposals must remain valid for a minimum of 60 days from the bid opening date.

Evaluation Criteria

Price will be considered as an essential part of the evaluation. While cost is a significant factor, the award will not automatically be made to the lowest bidder. Instead, the City will evaluate proposals based on overall value, considering project approach, experience, and price. The evaluation will be weighted as follows:

- References 20%
- Experience with the city of Lucas 10%
- Experience 20%
- Price 40%
- Experience with projects with this scope 10%

Requests for Clarification

Any prospective bidder requiring clarification or interpretation of this solicitation must submit a written request no later than five (5) days prior to the scheduled bid opening. Requests must be directed to **Joe Hilbourn at jhilbourn@lucastexas.us**. Responses will be provided to all known prospective bidders in the form of a written addendum.

It is the bidder's responsibility to verify receipt of all addenda. Addenda will be distributed to known bidders and posted on the City of Lucas Purchasing Website. Bid packets are also available online at: http://www.lucastexas.us/finance/purchasing/bid.

The City of Lucas shall not be responsible for failed internet connections or power interruptions.

Sidewalls 4:12 Roof Pitch Welded Red Iron Steel Frame, I Beam and C- Purlin free span construction. 16-gauge 8 in. primer painted C- Purlin used throughout Building. 



House Bill 89 Verification Form

Prohibition on Contracts with Companies Boycotting Israel

The 85th Texas Legislature approved new legislation, effective September 1, 2017, which amends Texas Local Government Code Section 1. Subtitle F, Title 10, Government Code by adding Chapter 2270 which states that a governmental entity may not enter into a contract with a company for goods or services unless the contract contains a written verification from the company that it:

- 1) does not boycott Israel; and
- 2) will not boycott Israel during the term of the contract

Pursuant to Section 2270.001, Texas Government Code:

- 1. "Boycott Israel" means refusing to deal with, terminating business activities with, or otherwise taking any action that is intended to penalize, inflict economic harm on, or limit commercial relations specifically with Israel, or with a person or entity doing business in Israel or in an Israeli-controlled territory, but does not include an action made for ordinary business purposes; and
- 2. "Company" means a for-profit sole proprietorship, organization, association, corporation, partnership, joint venture, limited partnership, limited liability partnership, or any limited liability company, including a wholly owned subsidiary, majority-owned subsidiary, parent company or affiliate of those entities or business associations that exist to make a profit.
