Background Information:

Mrs. Aquirre is currently building a new home and would like to add a privacy fence that will be eight (8) feet tall and constructed of stone extending the entire length of the property. The fence will be located along Parker Road and will cut down on noise during the Parker Road widening project and assist with providing a buffer from traffic noise as well.

Section 3.19.002 (b) of the Code of Ordinances relating to residential, agricultural and estate districts states "fencing located within the required front, side and rear yard setbacks shall be a minimum of 50% see through.



Background Information:

On January 4, 2013 Brockdale Estates requested a variance for a specific sign at two locations. One sign was proposed at the southwest corner of Brockdale Park Road and FM 1378, which was approved and the second sign was proposed at East and West Lucas Road, this request was denied.

On August 27, 2015, Brockdale Estates requested for a second time to locate an off-site development sign at the northwest corner of the intersection of East and West Lucas Road, this request was denied again. This request was identical to the previous requests.

Brockdale Estates, LLC., is now requesting a variance for a new style of sign at the location that was approved January 4, 2013, the southwest corner of Brockdale Park Road and FM 1378.

It was determined that a Quorum was present. Everyone was reminded to turn off or silence cell phones. Chairman Fink led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Hearing

- 1. Public Hearing: Consider the request by Oak Crest Custom Homes for a variance from the literal interpretation of the City's Code of Ordinances to allow a fence exceeding 8 feet in height within the required front and side yard setbacks, and that is not 50% see through for the property located at 13 Manor Lane.
 - A. Presentation by Development Services Director Joe Hilbourn

A presentation was given by Development Services Director Joe Hilbourn stating that the proposed fence would be approximately 180 feet long following the natural contour of the land with a maximum fence height in that span of 15 feet tall. The tallest portion of the fence will be located on the side and rear of the property. Mr. Hilbourn stated that staff recommends approval of this request.

Chris Rodden with Oakcrest Custom Homes came forward and shared with the Board the site plan drawing of the property with the proposed fencing. The Board discussed the fence materials of stone and cedar as well as the proposed height of the fence along the fence line.

Chairman Fink opened the public hearing at 6:08pm and asked if anyone in the audience wanted to speak regarding this request.

Jerry Reber, 101 Manor Circle, stated that he lived adjacent to the applicant and was in favor of the fence proposed.

There being no one else wanting to speak, Chairman Fink closed the public hearing at 6:09pm.

MOTION: A motion was made by Mr. Sisson seconded by Mr. Bierman to approve the request for a fence exceeding 8 feet in height within the required front and side yard setbacks, and that is not 50% see through for the property located at 13 *Manor Lane. The motion passed unanimously by a 5-0 vote.*
