MEMORANDUM

DATE: January 28, 2014

TO: Mayor and City Council

FROM: Dan Savage, Interim City Manager

SUBJECT: Fire Department Proposed Two Year Budget

The state law that enables municipalities to create Fire Control, Prevention, and Emergency Medical Districts requires the temporary board (in this case the Lucas City Council) to adopt a two year budget. The budget plan must include: 1). the amount of money budgeted for each fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services strategy; 2). the amount of money budgeted and the percentage of the budget for administration; 3). the estimated amount of money available from all services; 4) the amount estimated to be available at the end of the years for which the budget is prepared; and 5). The estimated tax rate required to support the budget.

To address these requirements I recommend that the City Council, acting as the temporary board for the Lucas Fire Control, Prevention, and Emergency Medical District to consider the following: "The district may finance all costs of a fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services district program, including costs for personnel, administration, expansion, enhancement, and capital expenditures."

There is nothing in the law that addresses whether or not district funds can be used to supplant previous expenditures included in the City's general fund budget for the Fire Department. Since the normal budget preparation process for the next fiscal year will not begin for at least four months, it might be helpful to address the budget plan by using past funding commitments. For example, the full personnel cost for one Firefighter/EMT is \$58,354. The cost of one Firefighter/Paramedic is \$61,207. The cost of the lease purchase of the new ambulance and related medical equipment is \$62,688.

The personnel costs may change slightly in each of the next two years, but the lease purchase payments will remain constant for the life of the lease.

Using these budget costs, the following addresses the fire requirements of the budget plans.

At the end of two years the fund balance will total about 9% of the annual revenue. There will undoubtedly be some increase in personnel costs in both FY 2015 and FY 2016 budgets. Hopefully there will also be an increase in the $\frac{1}{2}$ cent sales tax revenue.

The above presented budget will allow you to meet the requirements of the law relating to the preparation of a two year budget and will also give you the opportunity to consider new initiatives in the Fire Department budget during the normal budget process. For example, if you wish to add new positions, new equipment, and new programs, it could be done through the normal budget process.

I will review this proposal with the City Attorney before putting it on the City Council meeting agenda.

Fire District Services Plan

The Lucas Fire Department will use the Fire District funding for two Firefighters/EMT positions to continue providing 24/7 coverage with two paid firefighters working in conjunction with five other paid staff over and 40 trained volunteers to ensure adequate staffing and consistent response time for fire emergency calls.

Emergence Medical Services

The Lucas Fire Department will use the Fire District funding to help support the implementation of Advanced Life Support ambulance service by paying for one Firefighter/Paramedic position and by paying for the annual lease purchase payment for a new ambulance with supporting equipment.

Evaluation of Fire Control

The addition of paid staffing to the Lucas Fire Department in FY 2014 was designed to enhance fire call response times and to enable the department to implement Advanced Life Support ambulance services. Response time improvements will be the measure of efficiency and effectiveness for both services. The Advanced Life Support ambulance service will take over from the East Texas Medical Service provider. Average

response time for each service should improve with the availably of full time 24/7 staffing and the availability of in city ambulance service.

A RESOLUTION OF THE TEMPORARY BOARD OF THE LUCAS FIRE CONTROL, PREVENTION, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE DISTRICT ORDERING A SPECIAL ELECTION TO BE HELD ON SATURDAY, MAY 10, 2014, FOR THE PURPOSE OF CREATING THE LUCAS FIRE CONTROL, PREVENTION, AND EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES DISTRICT AND THE ADOPTION OF A LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 344.051 of the Texas Local Government Code, the City Council of Lucas proposed the creation of the Lucas Fire Control, Prevention, and Emergency Medical Service District (the "District") through the passage of Resolution No. R-2014-01-00408 on January 24, 2013; and

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Section 344.061 of the Texas Local Government Code, the Temporary Board of Directors of the District has established a two-year fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services plan and a two-year budget plan which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A"; and

WHEREAS, the Temporary Board desires to call and hold a confirmation election pursuant to Section 344.054 of the Texas Local Government Code for the creation of the District and establishing a sales and use tax to be used for financing the operations of the District;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TEMPORARY BOARD OF THE DISTRICT, THAT:

SECTION 1. A Special Election is hereby ordered to be held in and throughout the City of Lucas, Texas, on May 10, 2014, for the purpose of creating a fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services district (the "District") and adopting a sales and use tax to be used for financing the operation of the District.

- **SECTION 2.** A summary of the proposed District's budget plan and fire control, prevention, and emergency medical services plan is attached as Exhibit "A"
- **SECTION 3.** Notice of the special election, attached as Exhibit "B", shall be posted on the bulletin board used to post notice of the City Council meetings no later than the twenty-first day before Election Day. The notice of the special election shall also be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City no earlier than the thirtieth day and no later than the tenth day before Election Day. Notice of the special election shall also be posted as required by Section 344.056 of the Texas Local Government Code. The notice shall state the nature and date of the election, the wording of all ballot propositions, the location of each polling place, hours that the polls will be open, and any other early voting and election-related information required by law. The notice must be provided in both English and Spanish. A copy of the published notice that contains the name of the newspaper and the date of publication shall be retained as a record of such notice, and such person posting the notice shall make a record of the time of posting, starting date and the place of posting, and such person shall sign said record.
- **SECTION 4.** The Board is authorized to sign the Order and Notice of General Election that shall be published in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code.
- **SECTION 5.** The Office of the City Secretary shall perform all duties normally performed by the County Clerk in a general election with respect to early voting, giving notice of the election and preparing the official ballots and is hereby appointed as the Election Clerk.
- **SECTION 6.** The City Secretary is expressly authorized to obtain election supplies and equipment required by law and necessary to conduct said election.
- **SECTION 7**. The City Secretary is authorized to recruit qualified election workers and return to the City Council a Resolution approving the selected election workers.
- **SECTION 8.** On May 10, 2014, the voting for said election shall take place at 665 Country Club Road, Lucas, Texas. The polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Paper ballots, electronic voting systems, and hand counting shall be used for voting in the said election.
- **SECTION 9.** Early voting shall be conducted by the Office of the City Secretary in the Lucas City Hall, 665 Country Club Road and electronic voting system as well as paper ballots shall be used for early voting by mail and direct personal appearance for the election shall commence on April 28, 2014, at 8:00 a.m. and end at 7:00 p.m. on May 6, 2014. Early voting by personal appearance shall be conducted during the regular business hours of the City Secretary's Office each business day from 8:00 a.m. until 5:00 p.m., except for the Tuesday, April 29, 2014, and May 6, 2014. On the Tuesdays specified, early voting by personal appearance, the City Secretary's regular business hours are hereby designated as 7:00 a.m. until 7:00 p.m. Temporary Deputy Early Voting Clerks are hereby designated to assist in the absence of the Early Voting Clerk (City Secretary) during the said election and early voting. Jeanine Harvell, Delta Moody,

Jennifer Faircloth, Donna Bradshaw, Cheryl Meehan, and Linezka Maduro are duly appointed as Temporary Deputy Early Voting Clerks for the City of Lucas. Each shall serve in full capacity as the Early Voting Clerk in the absence of the Early Voting Clerk (City Secretary).

SECTION 10. The City Hall, located at 665 Country Club Road, Lucas, Texas, is hereby established as the Counting Station to receive and tabulate votes and ballots cast in said election. The following persons are hereby authorized and approved as persons employed and designated to handle the ballots, count the ballots, and to be present in the Central Counting Station:

- (a) Presiding Election Judge
- (b) Alternate Judge/Clerk
- (c) Clerks
- (d) Early Voting Clerk/City Secretary
- (e) Temporary Deputy Early Voting Clerks

SECTION 11. Should any word, sentence, paragraph, subdivision, clause, phrase or section of this ordinance be adjudged or held to be void or unconstitutional, the same shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of said ordinance, which shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 12. This resolution shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.
