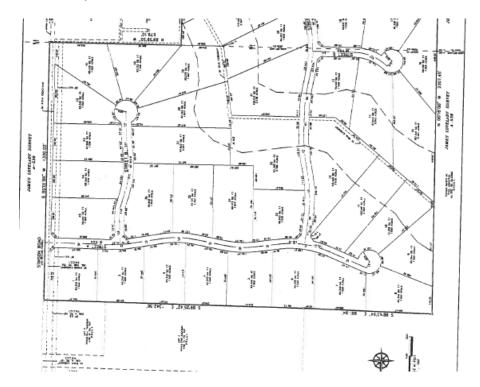

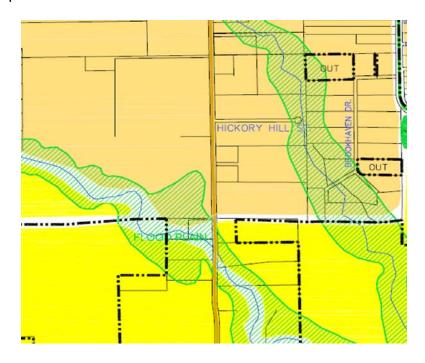
This parcel has an approved Development Agreement with an approved Concept Plan that gives consideration to the zoning. This plan adheres to the approved layout.

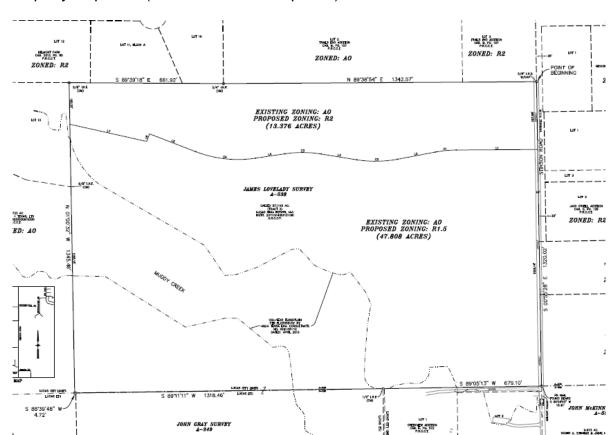

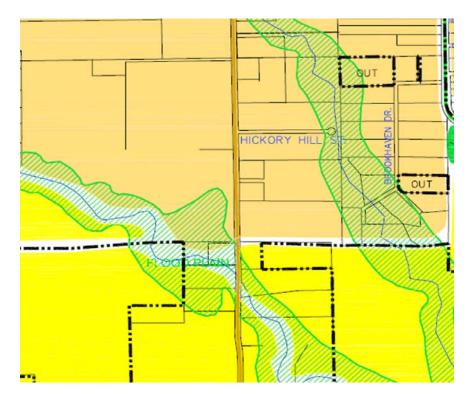

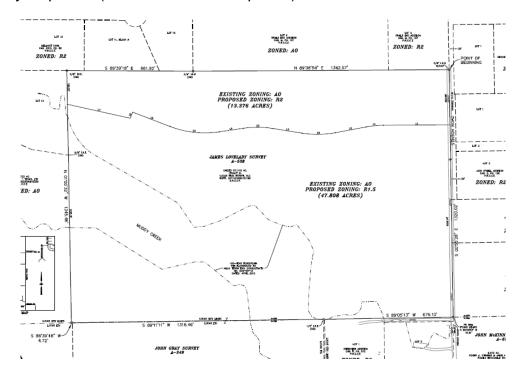

On August 1st the City Council approved a Development Agreement for this property to include additional right-of-way dedication and improvements to the 90° turns on Forest Grove (raised medians, greater radii). The agreement required upgrading the waterline and remediating drainage issues on Forest Grove. The developer would be reimbursed through Impact Fee credits, applied against the actual improvement costs only. The developer is responsible for cost averages of improvements.



The current zoning allows approximately 5-7 acres of 1 acre lot minimums. The remaining lots, approximately 46-48 acres, will be a minimum of 2 acres in size. Overall the 27 lots would be an average of 1.75 acres in size; the minimum being 1.5 acres and maximum of 2.67 acres as called out in the Development Agreement.

Homes built in the development will be approximately 3,500 - 5,700 square feet and proposed price range will be \$500,000 - \$800,000.

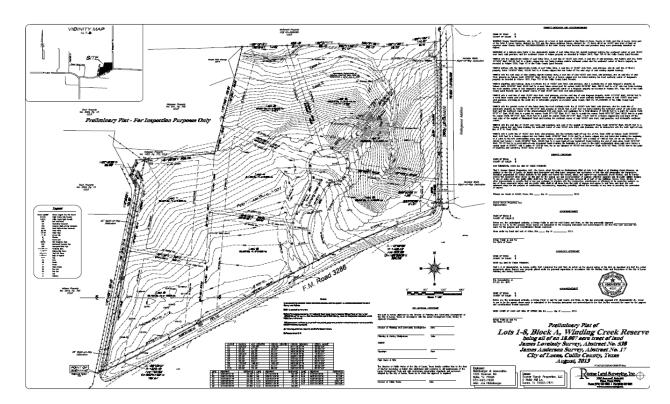

Only one point of access is required being that the development is less than ten (10) lots. The water main is looped from Winningkoff Road to Lost Valley, with a fire hydrant on Lost Valley.

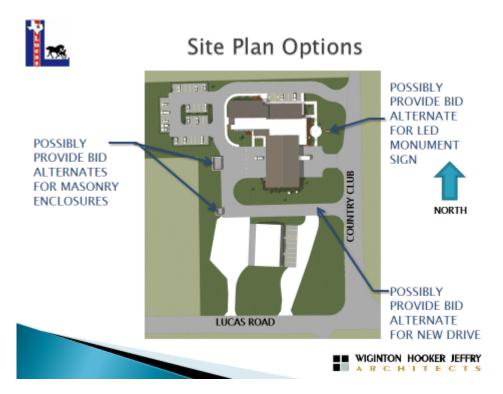

The code currently requires a public hearing. Section 14.03.354 Subsection (3) the site plan may only be approved following a public hearing before the Planning & Zoning Commission and the City Council. State Law says that site plans are an administrative approval. Administrative approval means that if it meets the city's requirements by law it must be approved. The public hearing gives the citizens a false sense that they have input whether or not the site plan is approved. Staff recommends that site plans continue to be approved by the Planning & Zoning Commission and City Council, not necessary to be presented as a public hearing.

Discuss and Consider a variance request to the tree removal and replacement plan pursuant to Chapter 3, Sec. 3.18.0011 of the City of Lucas' Code of Ordinances.

RECOMMENDED ACTION:

Concentrate the replacement of trees between the existing residential district and the commercial district to create a natural screen between the two zones. A masonry wall less than eight feet in height would not create an effective buffer because of the depth of the ravine separating the two properties.

SUMMARY:

Rudy Rivas has asked for a tree removal permit for Lucas corners located at 120 W. Lucas Road. In non-residential districts staff is permitted to issue tree removal permits unless there are more than three protected trees to be removed in a ninety day period

The planning staff or the city council, where applicable, shall deny a tree removal permit or application for variance, if it is determined that:

- (1) Removal of the tree is not necessary in order to conduct anticipated activities on the property;
- (2) A reasonable accommodation can be made to preserve the tree; or
- (3) The purpose and intent of this article is not being met or is being circumvented by the applicant.

Except as provided in <u>section 3.18.005</u>, no person, directly or indirectly, shall cut down, destroy, remove or move, or effectively destroy through damaging any protected tree situated on property regulated by this article without first obtaining a tree removal permit, unless otherwise specified in this article.

Sec. 3.18.009 Review and approval of tree removal permits and tree replacement plans

The planning staff shall be responsible for the review and approval of all requests for tree removal permits and tree replacement plans submitted in accordance with the requirements specified herein.

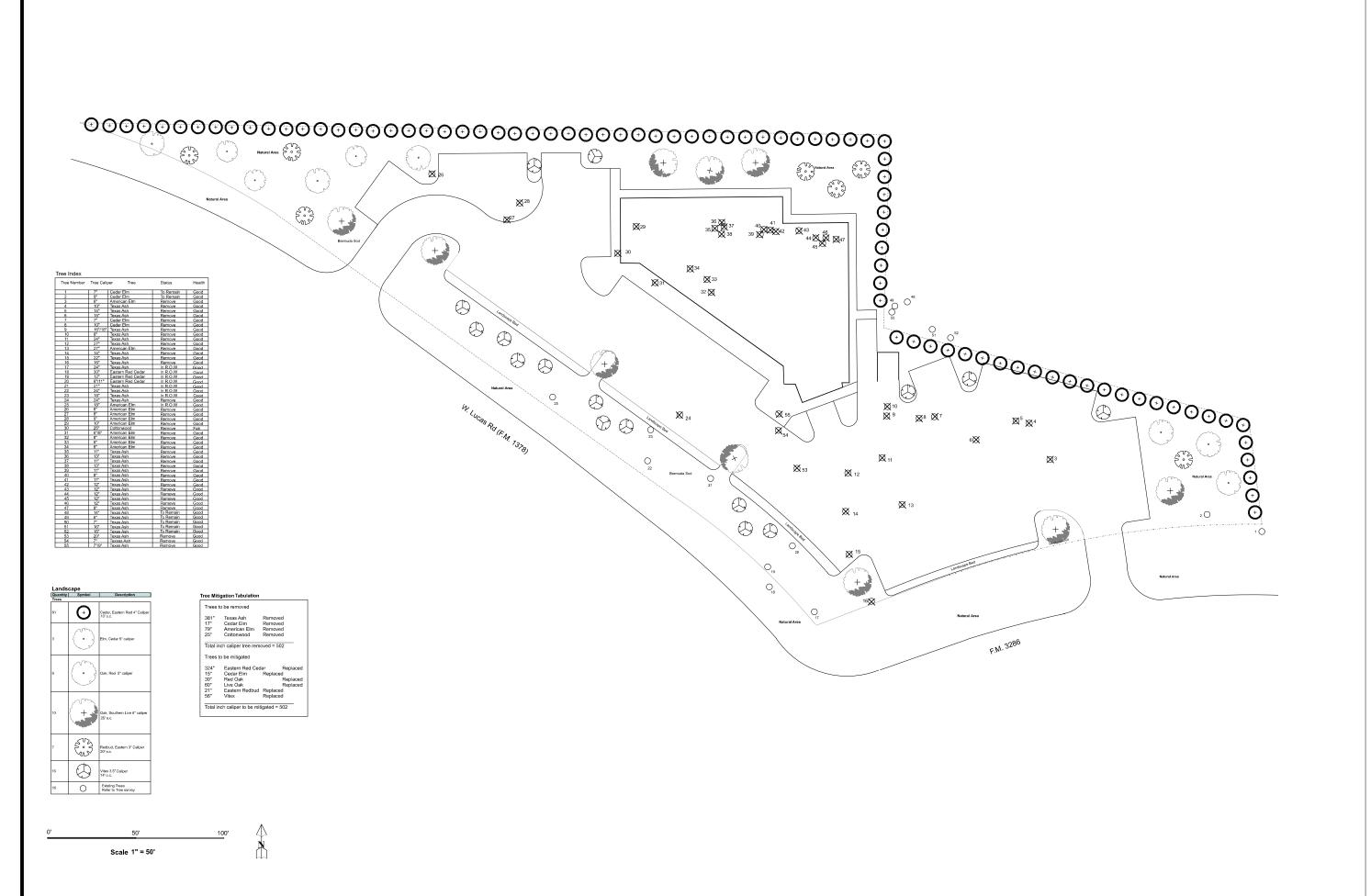
(e) <u>Contents of map</u>. Maps shall show the location of all buildings, structures, pools, utilities, and other improvements intended on the lot and limits of construction lines shown if applicable; the location of tree(s) to be removed and replacement trees with dimensions from the two nearest property lines; the caliper and common name of trees to be removed; and any required replacement trees shown with caliper size and the common name of the tree.

Sec. 3.18.011 Granting of Variances

MOTION:

The planning staff shall be allowed to consider variances or exceptions to the tree removal permit and tree replacement plan where literal enforcement would result in creation of an unnecessary hardship or impractical application of the plan considering the physical characteristics of the lot or parcel of land in question, except that any variance request for the removal of three (3) protected trees or more within 90 days shall be deferred directly to the city council.

Subject: Acquisition of Ambulances and Support Equipment

Council has previously been briefed on the lease purchase of a new and a used ambulance for the Fire Department. The proposal involved a \$375,000 lease purchase package. Three proposals were received. The lowest cost proposal was from American National Bank. This proposal requires the City to put up the vehicle title as collateral. The second lowest proposal is from Government Capital, but this proposal does not require the City to put up any collateral.

The spread on costs for the \$375,000 package between American National and Government Capital is \$1,389.32 per year for six years, but the bank will require the City to pay up to \$5,000 in closing costs.

If the City Council wants to go ahead with the American National proposal, then Staff will negotiate the final package and bring it back to the City Council. If the Council want to avoid putting up collateral, then Staff will negotiate a final package with Government Capital.

A more significant issue is whether or not the City wants to include the used ambulance in the lease package. The original budget funded a used ambulance at \$50,000. The Fire Chief and his Staff have found a used vehicle in Florida that is available for \$27,000. The City Council may wish to consider buying the vehicle outright and reduce the lease package accordingly. Attached is a presentation from Fire Chief Kitchens that addresses the two options. If the used vehicle is purchased outright, then it could be fully equipped using the \$345,000 package. That would give the City a backup ambulance fully equipped in the event that the first line ambulance is on another call or transport or otherwise out-of-service.

I would recommend that you choose option 2. While the outright purchase of the used vehicle is not included in the Fire Department budget, your General Fund balance will support this purchase. Also, since the budget was approved, the City has realized an additional \$28,000 in property tax collections for FY 2013.

EMS Lease Agreement Used Ambulance



- The used 2007 ambulance on a Ford 450 Chassis is located near Tampa Florida. It has 71,000 miles on the chassis and appears to be in excellent condition. It was a front line ambulance with the St. Petersburg fire department until this year.
- ➤ The plan is to fly two fire department members to Florida to inspect the unit, one of the members is Chief Craig Zale. Chief Zale has the expertise to accomplish this task.



EMS Lease Agreement Used Ambulance Located



- ➤ If the decision is made to purchase the ambulance, the funds will be wired to Florida and the two members will begin the drive back to Lucas
- > We will allow up to three days to drive back due to the distance of 1100 miles back to Lucas.



EMS Lease Agreement Update



- ➤ In previous discussions council was informed, per state requirements, we are required to have a back up ambulance to cover our primary ambulance.
- ➤ A plan has been developed, and approved by the state, that will allow for two front line ambulances. The second ambulance will be listed as an MICU capable ambulance, totally equipped at all times, and staffed with on call personnel (volunteers) only. This plan will allow the backup ambulance to run on second calls received by the department. Because we will not have to wait on a mutual aid ambulance, response times will not be extended on second calls.









EMS Lease Agreement Staff Recommendations



- > Approve a budget adjustment of \$27,000 for the purchase of the 2007 used ambulance.
- ➤ Authorize the City Manager to negotiate a lease agreement with Government Capital in the amount of \$345,000.00 over six years with the first payment due March of 2014.
