Dear Chief Ted Stephens:

Insurance Services Office (ISO) has submitted a recommendation that extends your fire department response to an area outside the city limits. This area is an Outside Protected Area (OPA) and is limited to the area marked on the map that came with the request. This does not apply to the area within the city limits or the area covered by the Public Protection Classification (PPC). Currently, the area outlined in the OPA is a Class 02/2X.

Insurance Services Office is recommending the Public Protection Classification for the OPA to be changed to a split Class 01/1X with an effective date of 10/1/2022. The recommendation is based on a review of your community performed on 2/4/2022 and does include application of the Texas Exception to the Fire Suppression Rating Schedule.

With a split class, all class-rated properties located within 1000 feet of a fire hydrant or water supply suction point and within 5 road miles of a fire station will use Class 01. All class-rated properties located farther than 1000 feet of a fire hydrant or water supply suction point and within 5 road miles of a fire station will use Class 1X.

Public Protection Classifications range from 1 (superior) to 10 (does not meet minimum criteria).

We have reviewed the information provided and believe it is enough to grant approval. The Insurance Services Office will be notified of our approval of their recommendation and the effective date.
