FM 1378 from FM 2514 (Parker Road) to FM 2786 (East Stacy Road)

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) is conducting the Farm-to-Market (FM) 1378 Feasibility Study to evaluate the possibilities for widening and realigning FM 1378 from FM 2514 (Parker Road) north to FM 2786 (East Stacy Road), approximately 6.4 miles located in Collin County, Texas. The study will lead into further project development for the east-west section along West Lucas Road from FM 3286 Intersection Improvements Project to West Lucas Road, for approximately 0.8 miles. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting an in-person and online virtual public meeting on the proposed project. **The same information will be available at both the in-person and virtual meetings.**

The in-person meeting will begin at 6 p.m. and will be an open house format where the public may come and go at their convenience. Staff will be available to answer questions and take comments. The virtual meeting can be viewed beginning Tuesday, April 5, 2022, starting at 6 p.m. through Wednesday, April 20, 2022, at 11:59 p.m. CT. The virtual public meeting materials will be posted to the project website at www.keepitmovingdallas.com/FM1378 and will consist of a pre-recorded video presentation that includes both audio and video components, along with other exhibits. The virtual public meeting is not a live event. If you do not have internet access, please call Liang Ding, P.E., at (214) 320-6625 between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m., Monday through Friday, in order to ask questions and access project materials during the project development process. **Please note the materials will not be available until April 5, 2022, at 6 p.m.**

The FM 1378 Feasibility Study is being conducted to evaluate possibilities for widening and realigning FM 1378. The information gathered from the feasibility study would lead to the schematic design and environmental document for a proposed widening project on FM 1378 from the FM 3286 Intersection Improvement Project to West Lucas Road (approximately 0.8 miles). For the segment of FM 1378 from the FM 3286 Intersection Improvement Project to West Lucas Road, the proposed project would, subject to final design considerations, require 6.46 acres of additional right-of-way and potentially displace four residences and one non-residential structure. Relocation assistance is available for displaced persons and businesses. Information about the TxDOT Relocation Assistance Program and services and benefits for those displaced and other affected property owners, as well as information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction, can be obtained from the TxDOT district office by calling (214) 320-4469 or by visiting the project website.

Any maps and drawings showing the project location and design, tentative construction schedules, and other information regarding the proposed project are available for inspection Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. at TxDOT Dallas District, 4777 E. U.S. Highway 80, Mesquite, Texas 75150. Project materials are also available online at www.keepitmovingdallas.com/FM1378.

The virtual public meeting and the in-person public meeting option will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you.
