NOTICE TO BIDDERS

Notice is hereby given that the City of Lucas, Texas is now accepting bids at the office of the Purchasing Agent, Lucas City Hall, for all labor, material, equipment, and performance of all work required for the **West Lucas Road Elevated Storage Tank**, with all necessary appurtenances.

Submit one (1) original bid with required signatures, in a sealed envelope or package to the Purchasing Department at 665 Country Club Road, Lucas, Texas 75002 on or before **2:00 p.m., Tuesday, October 3, 2023**. Bids must be clearly marked "WEST LUCAS ROAD ELEVATED STORAGE TANK – DO NOT OPEN UNTIL 2:00 P.M., TUESDAY, OCTOBER 3, 2023." The bids will then be publicly opened and read.

A Pre-Bid meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, September 19, 2023 at 2:00 P.M. Attendance is not mandatory.

The proposal from the lowest responsible bidder will be presented to the City Council for consideration on October 19, 2023 at the regularly scheduled city council meeting.

The City of Lucas reserves the right to adopt the most advantageous interpretation of the bids submitted in the case of ambiguity or lack of clearness in stating bid prices, to reject any or all bids, and/or waive any informality in bids received. Bids may not be withdrawn within sixty (60) days from the date on which bids are opened.

Bids shall be accompanied by a cashier's or certified check upon a national, state bank or savings and loan in an amount not less than five percent (5%) of the total maximum bid price, payable without recourse to the City of Lucas, or a bid bond in the same amount from a reliable surety company, holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as surety, as a guarantee that the bidder will enter into a contract and execute performance bond and payment bond within ten (10) days after notice of award of contract to him. The notice of award of contract will be given by the Owner within sixty (60) days following the opening of bids.

The low bidder must qualify within five working days after bid opening by submitting evidence as the City of Lucas may require to establish the financial responsibility, experience, and possession of such equipment as may be needed to prosecute the work in an expeditious, safe and satisfactory manner. Should the bidder fail to produce evidence satisfactory to the City as stipulated in the specifications on any of the foregoing points, they may be disqualified and the work awarded to the next bidder so qualifying.

The successful bidder must furnish Performance Bond upon the form provided in the amount of 110 percent of the contract price and a Material and Labor Payment Bond upon the form provided in the amount of 110 percent of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Texas to act as surety or other sureties acceptable to the Owner.

Contractors for this Project must comply with prevailing wage rates as defined by the United States Department of Labor Davis and Bacon Wage Determination at <http://www.wdol.gov/dba.aspx>.

The bidder selected by the City of Lucas shall furnish proof of insurance prior to bid award in the form of an insurance certificate to the Purchasing Department.

Plans purchased from Plan Rooms or third-party websites shall be at the Bidder's sole risk. No guarantee of receipt of Addenda will be made for third-party downloads.
