We now have a City of Lucas Web Map Portal that is open to the public. The portal is based on GIS mapping of the city and has a range of valuable tools for measuring, creating printouts and locating important information such as zoning and land use classifications, floodplain boundaries, and the locations of local trailheads. It also provides useful links to property information from the Collin Central Appraisal District and high-quality aerial images. Just like the watering schedule, it is available from the city's homepage at www.lucastexas.us.

If you have any trouble using the portal there are some helpful instructions under the "i" icon at the top right of the page. This will help explain some of the tools available in the portal. The Planning and Zoning Commission will be looking at the Capital Improvement Plan to make recommendations to the City Council. BAIT SHOP INTERSECTION (FM 1378 / FM 3286) **UPDATES**

The preparation work for the West/East Lucas Road to Southview Drive intersection (also known as the Bait Shop Intersection) has continued through the summer and into September. The Grayson-Collin Electric Cooperative (GCEC) is expected to complete all electrical relocation by the end of September, followed by telecommunication companies completing their relocations immediately following GCEC's

According to Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) personnel, construction on the Bait Shop Intersection project will begin in late October or early November 2023. Once preconstruction meetings are held, official contractors will provide City of Lucas staff with a start date and proposed traffic control changes, if there are any that deviate from the original plans.

More details on this development and the construction at the Bait Shop Intersection will be provided in further updates in the Lucas Leader. 
