What is the purpose of the new City Master Plan?

- **Guiding document** for future development and capital improvements that reflects the community's vision for the future of Madeira Beach
- Replace the 2002 Master Plan to address evolving community needs and implement modern, sustainable practices and solutions
- The Master Plan will **identify goals, objectives, and implementation strategies** that will:
 - Address local challenges,
 - Help our City adapt to future conditions, and
 - Enhance quality of life for all who live, work, and visit Madeira Beach.

How does the Master Plan work with other city planning documents?

Broad



Comprehensive Plan

- Long-term policy direction for the City (typically over a period of 20–30 years)
- Contains Goals, Objectives, andPolicies that provide direction for:
 - Future land use, housing, and transportation
 - The provision of public infrastructure, facilities, and services
 - The conservation/protection of natural resources
- **Legally-binding** document



Master Plan

- An action-oriented plan with detailed recommendations and phased implementation strategies to accomplish a community's goals (typically over a period of 5–15 years)
- Blueprint for future development and public improvements
- Not a legally-binding document





- Regulates how land is developed by providing specific standards for:
 - The types of development/land uses that can be built in different zones
 - The size, form, and placement of buildings to protect public health, safety, and welfare
 - How and when infrastructure must be provided to support new development
- **Legally-binding** document



What can the Master Plan accomplish?

What the Master Plan does:

- ✓ Identifies key projects and initiatives that will help the City adapt to evolving physical, socioeconomic, and environmental conditions over time
- ✓ Recommends design guidelines in specific areas to achieve a desired look, feel, or goal (e.g., to enhance walkability)
- ✓ Outlines a strategic approach to decision-making and development in the short- to mid-term that reflects the community's priorities

What the Master Plan does not do:

- X Set broad, long-term goals for the overall growth and development of the City
- Replace the need for a Comprehensive Plan or Zoning Code
- Require developers to follow design standards recommended in the Plan
- **x** Require City officials to make policy changes or certain budgetary decisions
