<u>Contain Yard Debris with landscape barriers (Mulch, shell, rock, leaves, dirt, tree debris)</u>

- DO NOT PLACE YARD DEBRIS ON THE ROAD, CURB, OR STORMDRAIN FOR PICKUP. Place all debris on your property and it will be picked up on Wednesday with all yard waste.
- Recycle grass clippings on your laws/mulch bins or bag and place out for pickup with your regular garbage pickup. DO NOT BLOW GRASS CLIPPINGS ON TO THE ROADWAY.

Do not pour/wash anything down stormdrains, they drain to the bay.

- Paint, Chemicals can be disposed of at Pinellas Counties Chemical collection center or mobile collection events

• Dispose of Swimming pool water properly

Chlorine pools- turn off chlorinator (24 Hours) and allow for levels to drop to zero (0). Drain water through grass, rocks, or stormwater sock to filter sediment.
