**RECOMMENDATION:** 1) Approve plans and specifications; 2) Direct the Clerk to advertise the Notice to Bidders on July 20 and July 27; and 3) Authorize the Clerk to call for bids to be opened at 3:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 5, 2021.

**SUMMARY:** The County's unincorporated road network condition has improved dramatically in the last decade due to concerted efforts to invest in our infrastructure. One of the strategies staff uses is to combine pavement rehabilitation work with other types of improvements when possible to avoid future trench cuts into otherwise good pavement. Improvements to Redwood Highway Frontage Road have been deferred for this reason, as the County has a future utility undergrounding project that should logically be completed before or at the same time as pavement rehabilitation.

However, there is a small segment of Redwood Highway Frontage Road (approximately 800 feet) from the north side of Seminary Drive to the southern driveway at 580 Redwood Highway Frontage Road that has deteriorated to the point that rehabilitation is needed now. The improvements needed include full width grinding, repairing road base failures, and asphalt resurfacing.

Construction will take place during the daytime hours with traffic control measures. Ten-minute delays during lane closures are expected; however, uninterrupted access will always be provided for emergency vehicles. Staff will coordinate with McDonalds to evaluate customer access impacts during the paving of the northbound lane only. All other businesses have at least one driveway outside the limits of the work. Every effort will be made to provide advanced notice and minimize inconvenience to residents and businesses.

Staff has evaluated this project in conformance with the Department's multi-modal policy.

**FISCAL IMPACT:** There are no net impacts to the General Fund net County costs as a result of your Board's action. The engineer's estimate for this project is \$350,000.00. Actual project costs are unknown until the contractor bids are opened. Funding for this project is available in current year Road & Bridge Program, Fund (1430).

#### 2021 REDWOOD HIGHWAY FRONTAGE ROAD PAVEMENT REPAIRS

County Project No. 2021-11

**Project Description:** Cold planning the full width of the road, HMA base failure repairs, and full width 6" HMA paving of a small segment of Redwood Highway Frontage Road (approximately 0.15 miles): from the north side of Seminary Drive to the north side of the southern driveway at 580 Redwood Highway Frontage Road. Work will also include utility cover adjustment and related incidental work.

The Engineer's estimate for this project is \$350,000. Bids are required for the entire work described herein. The Contractor shall possess a valid Class "A" License at time of bid submittal. A Bid Bond in the amount of 10% of the total bid amount payable to the County of Marin shall accompany the Proposal.

Work shall be done in accordance with plans and specifications which may be acquired at no cost in electronic format via email download. **Bidders can request bid documents** by emailing bids@marincounty.org or by completing a bid document request form here: https://bit.ly/3vLvnRG.
