Item 3. Zone 7 FY 2021-22 Budget Adjustment

Final Design and Easement Purchase: Easement purchase costs include \$1,000,000 in total compensation to approximately 100 property owners, a \$200,000 increase for two full-time real estate staff, \$400,000 for right of way-related consultants, and up to \$200,000 for owners to get reimbursed for their own appraisals if they request this. The professional services budget adjustment also includes \$100,000 for additional services such as the erosion and stormwater control plan, preparation of final plans and specifications for construction, and biological consulting support.

Recommend the Flood District Board of Supervisors approve the following Zone 7 budget adjustments to increase the Zone 7 expenditure budget by \$1.9 million for professional services, right-of-way agreements with property owners, and staff labor necessary to finalize design and acquire right-of-way contracts for parcels located along the entire length of the TRB upgrade project in Flood Zone 7:
