


## Flooding at Drake and Donahue


Question raised at Sept 2020 Flood Zone 3 Advisory Board Meeting: Intersection of Drake/Donahue is flooded on sidewalks and streets. What is feasible in the short term (upcoming winter) to reduce flood risk at this location?

# Short Term/Interim Measures Identified:

- ✓ Prioritize storm drainage catch basins in street for enhanced cleaning
- ✓ Select location for a new real-time flood level sensor/gage
- ✓ Transit Coordination & Planning for Future Flood Events

#### Also considered but not feasible this year:

- Temporary mobile pumps
- Elevate sidewalk (temporarily)
- Reroute pedestrians to less flood-prone areas



### Short Term Measures Identified...

✓ Prioritize Marin City storm drainage catch basins in public right of way for cleaning



**ECHO** with Tension Bar Installation




The ADS **ECHO** installs quickly making it easy to move from one location to another.


