#### Item 3. Open Time for Items Not on the Agenda

- AB supported continuing the leaves mailer in the fall and suggested revising for clear messaging.
- AB requested that City notify neighborhood of street sweeper days so that cars can be moved.
- AB requested an update on Zone 6 coordination with the City regarding the Merrydale development. Staff described that the developer sent a Title Report for the property being developed showing that the easement on the property had been transferred to the City in the 1970s. Without the easement the District is no longer a party to the development approval process.

# Item 4. Review Zone 6 FYs 2022-24 Baseline Budget

WR requested it on the record that the AB should have at least one meeting per year, even if held remotely, to review the budget. See staff report for budget.

# Item 5. Maintenance Agreement with City of San Rafael

See staff report for more information. AB requested to receive a copy of the maintenance agreement in advance of the Board of Supervisors meeting as well as the breakdown of prior years' work reported to the District by the City. AB requested including this term in the maintenance agreement: conduct maintenance twice per summer whenever feasible to better address both fire fuel and flooding concerns.

Action by Board: Recommend that the District Board of Supervisors approve the budget increase of \$27,000 per year for the City of San Rafael Maintenance Agreement.
