# 5. San Anselmo Flood Risk Reduction Project

## A. Sunnyside Nursery Flood Diversion and Storage Basin (FDS)

**Recommended Action:** Recommend the District Board of Supervisors increase appropriations in the Zone 9 miscellaneous expenses budget by up to \$600,000 for environmental compliance and/or plantings as required under project permits. The increase in appropriations will equal the amount of the final approved permits and agreements, and if more is needed the advisory board will be updated in advance. **Recommended Action:** Recommend the District Board of Supervisors increase appropriations in the Zone 9 professional services budget by up to \$900,000 for final design, permitting, and construction management services for the FDS project. The increase in appropriations will equal the amount of the final approved agreement(s), and if more is needed the advisory board will be updated in advance.

**Recommended Action:** Recommend the District Board of Supervisors increase appropriations in the Zone 9 construction budget by up to \$4,300,000 for construction of the FDS project. The increase in appropriations will equal the amount of the final approved agreement, and if more is needed the advisory board will be updated in advance.
