## ORDINANCE NO. 24-001

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, CLOSING, VACATING, AND ABANDONING AN ALLEYWAY AND EASEMENT AREA; PROVIDING FINDINGS OF FACT; AUTHORIZING CONVEYANCE OF SUCH ABANDONED ALLEY-WAY AND EASEMENT AREA TO THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNER BY A QUITCLAIM DEED; PROVIDING SEVERABILITY, OPEN MEETINGS, AND EFFECTIVE DATE CLAUSES; AND PROVIDING FOR RELATED MATTERS.

WHEREAS, Larry W. Jackson submitted an Application for the Vacation/Abandonment of Public Easement/Right-of-Way, or alleyway which included a survey of the subject alleyway and easement area as authorized by Chapter 25, Article VI of the Marlin Code of Ordinance;

WHEREAS, the alleyway and easement area requested to be abandoned is described in the survey and legal description in the attached Exhibit "A", is not necessary for use by the City of Marlin (herein the "City") as an alley or street and was never improved or used as an alleyway or public street by either the City or the general public and any easement area is not needed or necessary for the City's use;

**WHEREAS**, the City finds that there are no City utilities located in or upon the dedicated right-of-way to be vacated and abandoned;

WHEREAS, Larry W. Jackson owns the property abutting the alleyway and easement area described in the attached Exhibit "A";

WHEREAS, the City will no longer have any obligation or duty to improve or maintain the portions of the vacated and abandoned rights-of-way as provided in this Ordinance and that the maintenance and improvement of such portions of the vacated right-of-way, as provided in this Ordinance, shall be of the sole responsibility and obligation of Larry W. Jackson and any subsequent owner of the property;

**WHEREAS**, the City Council for the City of Marlin finds that the vacating of, abandonment of, and cessation and elimination of the City's obligation and duty to pay for any maintenance for the portions of the alleyway and easement area to be vacated and abandoned identified in the attached **Exhibit "A"**, as provided in this Ordinance, serves a public purpose for the City and for the Citizens of the City of Marlin;

WHEREAS, the notice and bidding requirements set forth in Section 272.001(a) of the Texas Local Government Code are not required, and pursuant to 272.001(b), (b)(1), and (b)(2), of the Texas Local Government Code, the requirements to obtain fair market value for the conveyance or transfer of the street rights-of-way is not required because Larry W. Jackson is the owner of the abutting property in fee simple;

# NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, THAT:

**Section 1. Findings.** The foregoing recitals are hereby found to be true and correct and are incorporated into this Ordinance as findings of fact by the City Council of Marlin, Texas.

Section 2. Right-of-Way. The alleyway and easement area described and depicted in the survey and legal description in the attached Exhibit "A" all as shown and described in the map attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein for all purposes, is hereby permanently closed, vacated, and abandoned by the City and the general public. No other portion of any other City street or right-of-way shall be vacated, closed, abandoned, or otherwise affected by this Ordinance.

**Section 3.** <u>Authorization to Execute Necessary Instruments</u>. The Mayor is expressly, authorized to execute a quitclaim deed for the alleyway and easement area r described in the survey and legal description in the attached **Exhibit "A"** to Larry W. Jackson, as provided by City Ordinance.

**Section 4.** Severability. Should any section or part of this ordinance be held unconstitutional, illegal, or invalid, or the application to any person or circumstance thereof ineffective or inapplicable, such unconstitutionality, illegality, invalidity, or ineffectiveness of such section or part shall in no way affect, impair or invalidate the remaining portion or portions thereof; but as to such remaining portion or portions, the same shall be and remain in full force and effect and to this end the provisions of this ordinance are declared to be severable.

**Section 5. Open Meetings.** It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Chapt. 551, Tex. Gov't. Code.* 

Section 6. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.




