Morris Watson Jr. is hereby declared duly elected to said office, subject to the taking of the oath of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

It is found, determined, and declared by the City Council that ________ received the highest number of votes cast for Councilmember Place 4, for Precinct No. 4, therefore, ______ was duly elected as Councilmember Place 2, for Precinct No. 2 to serve a two (2) year term of office that expires at the City's May 2026 general municipal election. ______ is hereby declared duly elected to said office, subject to the taking of the oath of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.

Joe Mark Taylor is hereby declared duly elected to said office, subject to the taking of the oath of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
- Section 4. Findings and Declarations for Special Election. It is found, determined, and declared by the City Council that a special election to elect a member of City Council for the unexpired term for the office of City Council, Councilmember Place 1, for Precinct No. 1, was duly called; that notice of said election was given in accordance with law, and that said special election was held in accordance with law.
- A. It is found, determined, and declared by the City Council that Michael Milnes received the highest number of votes cast for Councilmember Place 1, for Precinct No. 1, therefore, Michael Milnes was duly elected as Councilmember Place 1, for Precinct No. 1 to serve the remainder of the current (2) year term of office that expires at the City's May 2025 general municipal election. Michael Milnes is hereby declared duly elected to said office, subject to the taking of the oath of office as provided by the laws of the State of Texas.
- Section 3. <u>Elections Held in Accordance with Election Code.</u> The May 4, 2024 General Election and the May 4, 2024 Special Election were called and held in compliance with the Texas Election Code.
- Section 4. Open Meetings. It is further found and determined that written notice of the date, place, and subject of the special meeting of the City Council where this Resolution was considered was posted on the bulletin board located at City Hall, a place convenient to the public, and

said notice was posted continuously for at least 72 hours preceding the date of this meeting in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act.
