WATER QUALITY AND DRAINAGE SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

- **Name of Project and community:** Water Quality and Drainage System Improvements, City of Marlin
- **Name of CWSRF administering agency:** Texas Water Development Board
- **Funded in whole or in part by CWSRF through the EPA:** Wholly funded by CWSRF from the EPA and the TWDB
- **Brief description of project:** The City has experienced several major floods within the project area and have received a disaster declaration. The proposed improvements will be in an area generally bounded by 1st Street, Williams Street, Little Street and Lincoln Street. Utilities will be relocated as necessary to install the improvements. The storm sewer collection system will then drain to a new water quality pond structure in the Marlin City Park. The new water quality structure will then drain into an existing pond in the Marlin City Park then into Perry Creek which drains into the Brazos River.
- **Brief listing of water quality benefits:** This project will divert surface run-off to underground piping structures which will in turn convey stormwater run-off to a water quality structure to relieve the amount of sediment and debris from entering the receiving stream.
