ORDINANCE No. 18-018

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, RE-APPOINTING MUNICIPAL JUDGE FOR TWO YEAR TERM BEGINNING SEPTEMBER 2018; AND PROVIDING FOR HEALTH BENEFITS AS PART OF THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE'S COMPENSATION PACKAGE DEPENDENT ON WHETHER HIS ADDITION AS A COVERED PERSON IS ALLOWED UNDER THE CITY'S HEALTH PLAN/INSURANCE AND CONDITIONED ON THE COST TO THE CITY NOT EXCEEDING THAT WHICH WOULD NORMALLY BE PAID BY THE CITY FOR AN EMPLOYEE OF THE CITY.

WHEREAS, Denton Lessman has served as the Municipal Judge for the City of Marlin since 2013; and

WHEREAS, it is time for the terms of said official to be renewed or for others to be appointed in their place; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that the foregoing official should be appointed for new two year term.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS THAT:

- 1. Denton Lessman is appointed as the Municipal Judge of the City of Marlin, Texas for a term of two (2) years beginning on September, 2018.
- 2. Conditioned on such being available under the City's health plan/insurance, the Municipal Judge will be allowed to be covered under the City's health plan/insurance subject to any terms or waiting periods there under, and subject to the premium cost to the City not exceeding the cost for employee coverage that the City normally pays.
