

RESOLUTION NO. 20-010

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE DONATION OF A CITY-OWNED VEHICLE
TO THE MARLIN VOLUNTEER FIRE DEPARTMENT; AND AUTHORIZING THE
CITY MANAGER TO SIGN THE NECESSARY DOCUMENTS TO TRANSFER TITLE
TO THE VEHICLE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Marlin (“City”) owns title to a fire engine, known as Fire Engine No. 4, which is currently of no use or benefit to the City;

WHEREAS, the Marlin Volunteer Fire Department has requested that the City donate Fire Engine No. 4 to the Marlin Volunteer Fire Department;

WHEREAS, the City Council finds and has determined that the City has no need or use for Fire Engine No. 4 and that donating Fire Engine No. 4 to the Marlin Volunteer Fire Department to be used by the Marlin Volunteer Fire Department for fire-fighting activities shall serve a public purpose which will benefit the City and the residents of the City;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF MARLIN, TEXAS, THAT:

Section 1. The findings set forth in the preamble of this resolution are found to be true and correct and they are hereby adopted by the City Council as findings of fact.

Section 2. The City Council donates Fire Engine No. 4 to the Marlin Volunteer Fire Department for use in Marlin Volunteer Fire Department fire-fighting activities.

Section 3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to sign and deliver the title to Fire Engine No. 4 to the Marlin Volunteer Fire Department.

Section 4. It is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this resolution was passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the Open Meetings Act, *Chapter 551, Texas Government Code*.

Section 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its approval and passage as required by law.
