**Seeking: Water Plant Operator**

**PRIMARY DUTY:** Under basic supervision, performs a combination of basic and semi-skilled work in the operation of the Water Treatment Plant (WTP) for the City of Marlin.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:** Essential functions, as defined under the Americans with Disabilities Act, may include any of the following representative duties, knowledge and skills. Factors such as regular attendance at the job are not routinely listed in job descriptions, but are an essential function. Essential duties and responsibilities may include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Observes and monitors WTP equipment and process control system; cleans, maintains and adjusts equipment and components to meet WTP specifications; collects samples and checks equipment to verify proper operating conditions; maintains records of services performed.
- Assists in the operation of WTP facilities and equipment; performs work in accordance with all quality standards, safety regulations and procedures; duties will vary according to job assignment and skill level.
- Supports the relationship between the City of Marlin and the general public by demonstrating courteous and cooperative behavior when interacting with citizens, visitors and City staff; maintains confidentiality of work-related issues and City information.
- Performs other duties as required or assigned.

**MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

High School Diploma or GED equivalent is required.  
Knowledge of Water Operator functions a plus but not needed.  
Must possess a valid Texas Driver's License.  
Must pass a drug test.

**LICENSE AND CERTIFICATION**

- Must obtain a Class D Water License within 1 year from Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).
- Must obtain a Class C Surface Water License within 2.5 years from Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ).
- According to the needs of the City, additional training and certifications may be require.
